GUTS FOR GARTERS (IRE) launched a strong bid at 19th fence, drew even at last fence, led briefly in the stretch and was out finished. DRIFT SOCIETY (IRE) traveled reserved for 20 fences, was steadied after a big jump at the 6th, came charging at the last fence, and was outfinished. SERENE HARBOR gave chase the final mile, flattened out after 21st fence. IMPERIAL WAY was steadied after the third fence, was never a threat, got round the course. FOYLE lost rider at 18th fence. CATCH THE ECHO lost rider at 18th fence. ANY KEY fell at 6th fence. JOSHUA G. hampered by loose horse bumping his hind quarters at the 4th fence and fell. DERWINS PROSPECTOR hit rail of first fence, unseating rider.
